WHAS CRUSADE FOR CHILDREN



Thanks to WHAS Crusade for Children, CDCB was able to purchase a listening program for our children. Our staff is currently in training for the program to implement in the classrooms.

The WHAS Crusade for Children, Inc. established in 1954 by WHAS-TV, is celebrating their 50th anniversary. WHAS Crusade for Children raises money for schools, agencies and hospitals to better the lives of special needs children. In its first 55 years, the Crusade has raised more than \$128 million.

Thanks to generous contributions of goods and services, the Crusade is able to return 100% of all donations to organizations that serve special needs children in all 120 Kentucky counties and more than 50 southern Indiana counties. Fire departments raise more than 50 percent of the money each year by staging road blocks and other events. Approximately 3 million children have been helped by the Crusade since 1954.
